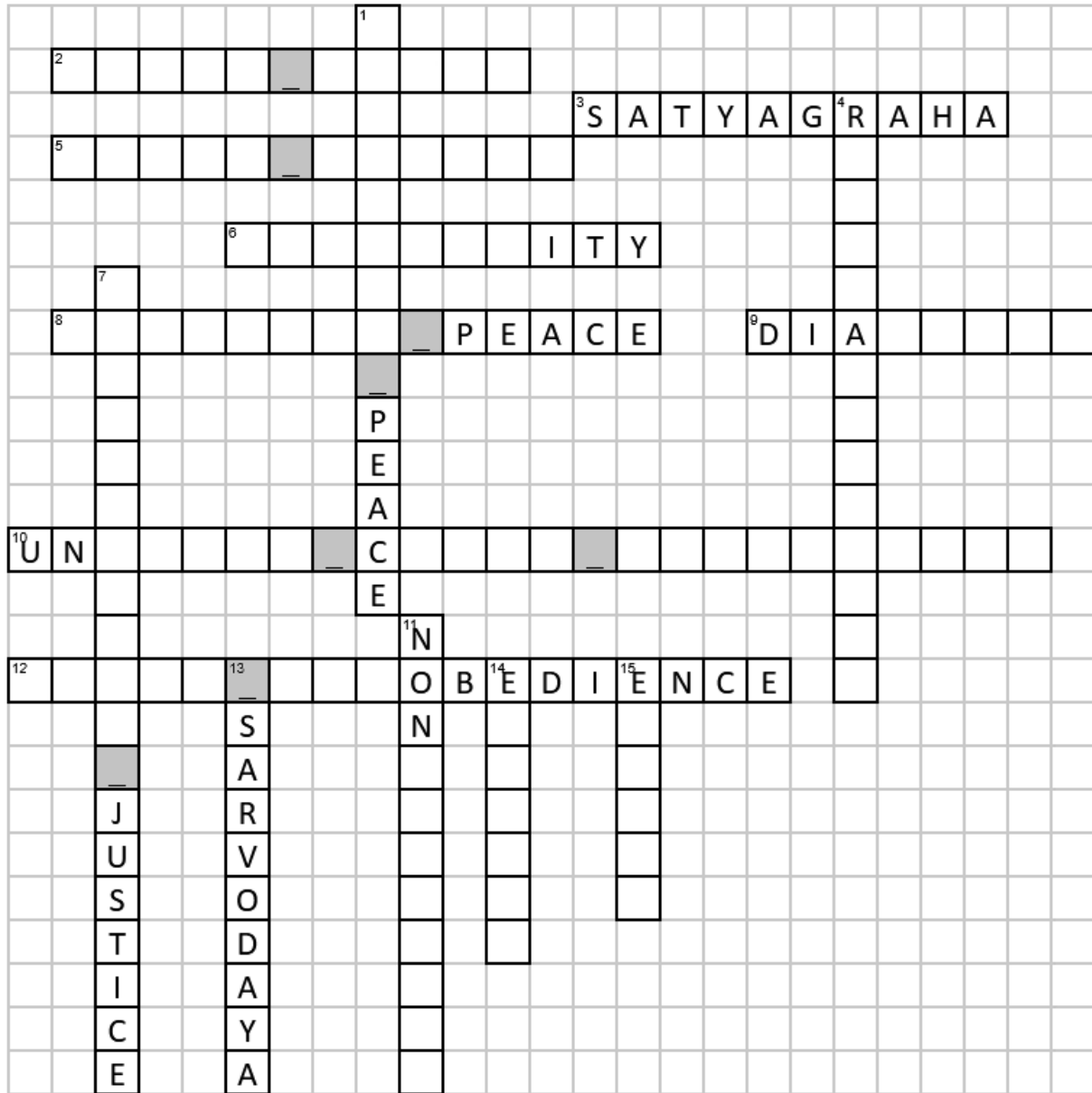


Crossword Puzzle: Peace Literacy
